Where are they?

Many scientists believe that there must be thousands or maybe even millions of extraterrestrial civilizations in the Universe. They must be there because we have been told by evolutionists that liquid water and correct temperature are the key conditions required to breed another intelligent race.

The search for aliens is becoming more and more popular. About 60 years ago the SETI (Search for Extra Terrestrial Intelligence) program was started which uses radio telescopes to search for signals from other stars and galaxies. The search is based on an assumption that any extraterrestrial civilization which wants to communicate with other civilizations will use radio or microwave signals similar to ours. So far, this program has not provided any evidence for the existence of extraterrestrial civilizations. In spite of this setback our fascination with extraterrestrial life has not diminished. This is reflected by an initiative instigated in 2015 by physicist Stephen Hawking calling for a more intensive search for aliens. So, we must believe in the existence of aliens otherwise why would we keep spending many millions of dollars, employ hundreds of scientists and use very expensive equipment, which could perform other important scientific tasks, on finding them?

Regardless of how much more money and time we may spend, it is most unlikely that we will establish contact with other civilizations. The search is based on false assumptions that aliens are only slightly more advanced than we are and use very similar communication technologies. If we look at our own civilization, would we have been able to contact it even two hundred years ago? Will we be able to contact it in two hundred years time? The probability, that other extraterrestrial civilizations are on a similar development level of science and technology to ours, is practically zero. They could be even billions of years ahead of us, and we know how much progress we have made in the past hundred years alone.

So where are they? I believe that they are here on Earth... Hold on. This is not as outrageous as you may think. When I proposed this hypothesis my first reaction was "this is impossible", but after investigating some unusual events I came to the conclusion "why not?" Looking at the history of our genesis you would agree that

intelligent beings have invested a lot of time and effort in us and therefore have a vital interest in our development and in the events on Earth. Even assuming that they could be located somewhere in our galaxy, they would not be able to travel distances of many thousands of light years very easily. They would have to be close to our solar system to take part in the design of life and other activities. In the past, life on Earth was developing in large steps separated by hundreds of millions of years of stasis, so their permanent presence on Earth was not necessary. However, the development of man's brain needed their close involvement since we know that several versions of *Homo* were prepared. The arising of modern and conscious man about 6000 years ago was the most important event in their experiment, and therefore they had to supervise his development. The easiest way would have been to do this from close quarters. Therefore, why might they not be on Earth, which is a very comfortable planet to live on?

The main scientific objection to this idea is that we are not able to detect them. At present Earth is covered by a very dense net of radar signals and satellite scanners, and is guarded by millions of CCTV cameras. Not to mention seven billion people watching the space around them in all possible corners of the Earth. Our surveillance technology is very advanced, close to the theoretical limits of physics. Optical devices placed on satellites are able to spot a single man on the surface of Earth and detect a hundred meter diameter rock several million kilometers away from us. So how can they avoid detection?

It is possible that the alien's bodies are not built from the same biological materials as we are. Or they could have technology which means their mode of transport does not reflect electromagnetic radiation, in a similar way to our stealth aircraft technology. If their materials also do not absorb electromagnetic radiation their vehicles could be perfectly transparent and therefore not visible.

The second major objection to the existence of aliens on Earth is that they have not contacted us yet. The simple answer is that they do not want to contact us. If they are very advanced, any direct contact could cause more damage to us than bring benefits. They might not want to contact us directly for the same reason that we want to protect tribes in the Amazon forest from any contact with civilization. A group of people being in contact with aliens would have a huge advantage over the remaining population and most likely would use this to their own benefit. Another reason for not

contacting us is that they do not want to upset our major religions which play such an important role in our society.

The third reason why we do not believe in their presence on Earth is that every year we are flooded with many thousands of reports of sightings of UFOs, meetings with aliens, etc. Most of them are products of our imagination, or our psychological needs. However within these thousands of sightings may be a few genuine events originated by extraterrestrials. Investigation of such sightings after the event is practically an impossible task, because we have to rely on the integrity and reliability of the observers. As a result, all these observations are ignored.

I believe that intelligent beings have contacted us, but on their own terms, without causing any harmful consequences. They contact us through intermediaries, using special religious events such as <u>apparitions</u> which comply with prevailing religious beliefs. The <u>display in the sky</u> in 1917 can be counted as such a contact.

Lights

The most common evidence of the presence of extraterrestrials comes in the form of lights in the sky. All different kinds of lights have been observed over more than 60 years. There are many reports from very reliable sources, such as pilots, of unexplained lights following aircrafts. Between 1952 and 1969 these sightings were listed in the 'Blue Book' and are currently also recorded on numerous UFO websites. When events in the Blue Book were analyzed most of them were rejected as being of man-made or of natural origins. However about 5 percent of them, even after very careful analysis by experienced scientists escaped the usual classifications and were left unexplained.

In practice it is difficult to investigate the nature of lights, especially when observed from a long distance over a short period of time, therefore it is impossible to prove their origin. However there are two sightings of lights which are very different from any other reported observations. In <u>1983 in Warsaw</u> five slow moving lights were viewed over several minutes from a distance of only about 60 m, which is a very unique happening.

Another important light observation took place in July <u>2012 in Warsaw</u> where two lights were circling in the sky at a height of about 400 meters. These lights moved on identical circular trajectories forming a figure of 8 and their movements were so

perfectly synchronized that every 20 seconds they crossed at the same point in the sky. The lights were observed for about 30 minutes and their position was not affected by strong wind. This type of display is also quite unique as it has never been observed before.

The available evidence belongs to two different categories. Display in the sky, having been witnessed by 50,000 people, is without any doubt the most unique and best documented extraterrestrial activity. While the display in the sky would indicate that intelligent beings were present within a few hundred kilometers from the location of events, the observed lights do not provide proof of their physical presence. The lights could easily have been part of their remotely controlled surveillance vehicles transmitting signals back to the control centre.

Being such a special event, one would assume that the Fatima display should generate wide interest, but this is not the case. Is it because the Fatima display is treated as a religious event? I think that there is a deep psychological reason for this rejection.

We all see ourselves as being open minded by accepting novelties such as new scientific discoveries, new religions and new political ideas. But there is a limit to how much we can accept. We want a secure life, nothing too upsetting, nothing too dramatic and anything which can destroy our equilibrium is rejected by our subconscious mind, whose objective is to protect our mental stability. As a result of this there is a strong unconscious resistance to accepting evidence for the existence of intelligent beings on Earth. We are prepared to accept the hypotheses of their activities somewhere in the Universe, thousands of light-years away from us, however accepting the existence of intelligent beings dwelling so close to us makes us very uncomfortable. When we look at the Fatima display, these events were very recent and close to us. They are well proven and well documented, witnessed by so many people that it is difficult to suspect any conspiracy or collusion. However, this evidence makes many people very uneasy to the extent that they refuse to listen to the arguments.
